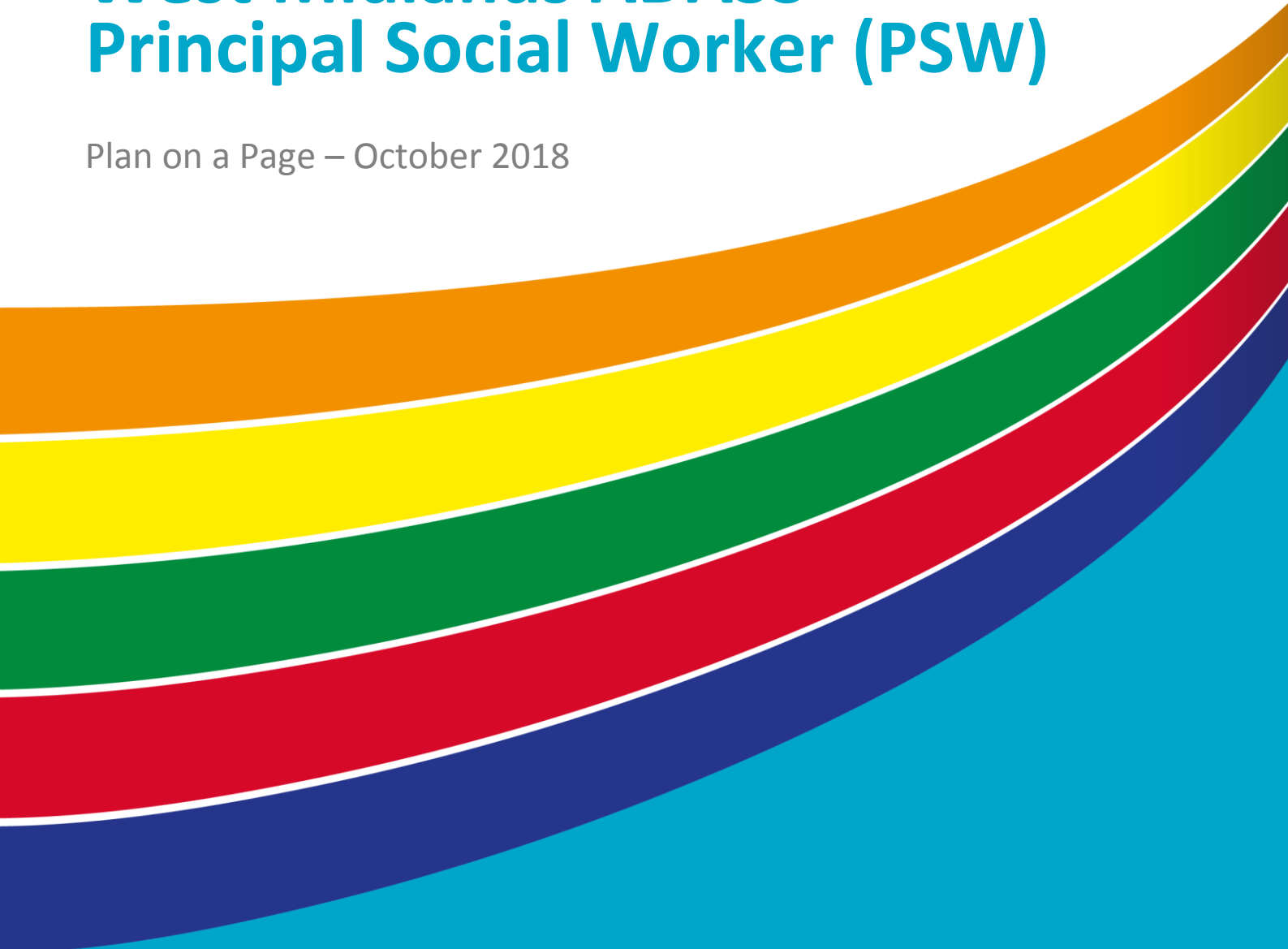

- Developing practice frameworks

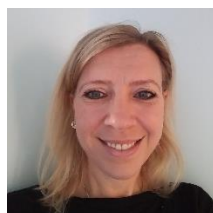
## Driven by Sector led improvement
